



The illustration shows a door that opens to the left. If the door opens to the right, the door handle will be reversed.







*The above table is a guideline for drying clothes that have been spin-dried for 5 minutes in a fully automatic washing machine at a room temperature of 20°C.

*Towels swell up to about 1.5 times the volume of regular clothes when dried, so the amount that can be dried at one time is smaller than that of other clothes.

The drying time is set to be light. Also, if you put too much regular clothes in the machine or push them in too tightly, the drying time will be longer.

This can result in uneven drying.

*Drying times may be longer than those shown in the table above depending on the type and thickness of the fabric.

*Dry weight is the mass when dry.

When dehydration is insufficient

Cooling operation


Cooling operation.

After drying is complete, the inside of the drum is hot. If oil remains on the clothes, there is a risk of spontaneous combustion, so the cooling operation starts automatically one minute after drying is complete. The cooling operation involves three minutes of continuous operation followed by intermittent drum operation for up to 40 minutes (the drum rotates for one minute approximately every four minutes). *The Clean Course and Pollen Care Course do not use gas, so the cooling operation does not take place.

To stop the cooling operation, press the Start/Pause switch, wait until the drum has completely stopped, then with the door open, press the Back switch until you hear a beep.



*If the temperature inside the drum is low, the process will finish quickly.




⚠️ caveat

When stopping the cooling operation, be sure to remove the clothes.

If oil remains on clothing, it may spontaneously combust.


How to fold sheets/blankets

Items that roll up and are difficult to dry, such as sheets and duvet covers



Fold the sheets and duvet covers one by one before placing them in the dryer. If they are rolled up and do not dry, repeat the process. The amount that can be dried at one time is up to 4 single size sheets for the 6kg capacity type and up to 2 double size sheets for the 9kg capacity type.

Blankets (Meyer blankets) and other items that are difficult to dry



Fold the blanket in half lengthwise and then place it in the folding screen. The maximum amount that can be dried at one time is one blanket for the 6kg capacity type. The maximum amount that can be dried at one time is two blankets for the 9kg capacity type. *If the blanket is new, some of the fur may fall out and accumulate in the lint filter, but this is just unwanted fur from the blanket, so there is no need to worry. *If the blanket is not completely dry due to insufficient dehydration, turn it over and dry it again.

Dryable blanket

- Single size items weighing 3.0 kg or less that are made from 100% synthetic fibers and have the following symbols:
- Meyer blankets
 - Tufted blankets
 - Woven blankets

*Drying on a cycle other than the sheet/blanket cycle will damage the blanket.

Do not dry out.



- Items with a pile length of 10mm or more (long pile) (there is a risk of the fabric becoming floppy)
- Electric blankets
- 100% wool blankets
- Items marked "Do not tumble dry"

What you need to know

How to dry properly (tips for drying)

To ensure proper drying, please pay attention to the following:


Do not put in too many clothes

• Overloading the machine may cause the drum to stall when starting or during operation.

To reduce uneven drying and wrinkles, loosen each

piece of clothing and smooth out any wrinkles before placing it in the machine.

• Standard drying capacity for the amount of clothing • As a guideline, use less laundry (70-80%) than what you put in the drum after spin-drying.



Below the drum center

• If you have only a small amount of clothes to dry, place them next to a dry bath towel to prevent uneven drying.

• If you have a mixture of thick and thin clothes, select the thick cycle.

Clothing with zippers or hooks

• Close any fasteners or hooks and turn the clothes inside out when drying. This will prevent damage to the fabric and the inside of the drum.



Clothes that produce a lot of lint

• Separate and dry new towels and other items that tend to produce lint separately. Lint will stick to clothing that contains synthetic fibers.



Reduce static electricity

• Use fabric softener when washing. • Use anti-static function. •

Display of remaining time (course operation)

• The remaining time is displayed according to the volume and moisture of the clothes.

• This is only an estimate, so it may differ from the actual end time. Also, when the filter lamp is on, the remaining time may not be displayed correctly.



• The remaining time is displayed in 5-minute increments, and when there is 1 minute remaining, is displayed.


• In order to adjust the estimated time until the end of the operation and the actual end time, if the same time is displayed for more than 5 minutes,

The remaining time may be extended or shortened depending on the adjustment. Also, the following message will be displayed during adjustment.



About static electricity reduction function

When you open the door, Plasmacluster ions are blown out from the Plasmacluster ion outlet. If you hold the air containing Plasmacluster ions against your hands, you can reduce static electricity when taking out clothes. The default setting is OFF. To turn it ON, see page 42 .



Note
 Do not insert your fingers or objects into the Plasmacluster ion outlet. This may result in injury or equipment failure.



notice

- Static electricity reduction effects vary from person to person.
- There is no need to replace the Plasmacluster ion generator.

A small amount of ozone is generated when Plasmacluster ions are generated, so there may be an odor from the outlet, but this is due to the natural environment, such as forests .

The level is the same as that found in the environment and does not pose any health problems.

About audio mode and volume settings

- You can switch the audio mode.

Friendly mode: Provides more guidance than "Standard". Standard

mode: Provides notification of safety device activation and guides for changing settings. To change settings, see page 40. • You can change

the volume. (Large, normal, small, off)



Note
 Do not place objects weighing more than 3kg on the small item drying rack. Do not dry shoes without using the small item drying rack. This may cause equipment failure.



When using the small item drying rack, make sure that the clothes do not hang over



the edge. Fold the clothes before placing them. Do not stack them too high (up to 20cm high). Do not place items that may fall.

Please be careful as the small item drying rack will be very hot immediately after use.



- Bags, slippers, toys
- Clothing that is sensitive to heat (Page 25)
- Clothing that may shrink (Page 25)

Note

Since it does not remove dirt, it cannot eliminate odors such as sweat or sebum.



Depending on the type and strength of the odor and the type of clothing, it may not be possible to completely eliminate odors. In that case, we recommend washing or dry cleaning.
